

Victorian Enduro Tour – series result rules



The following rules are relevant to the calculation of the series results for the 2017 - 2018 Victorian Enduro Tour. Individual races in The Tour will have their own rules and requirements that are relevant to that particular race, this document is only relevant to the calculation of series results across the 4 races.

In 2017 – 2018 the Victorian Enduro Tour will include 4 different events (also referred to as 'The Series'):

- **Race 1**, Nail Cairn, 11 – 12 November. Conducted by the Albury Wodonga MTB Club on the trails at Nailcairn Hill
 - **Race 2**, Mt Beauty, 20-21 January. Conducted by the Team Mount Beauty MTB Club on the Mt Beauty Trails
 - **Race 3**, Falls Creek, 10-11 February. Conducted by Falls Creek Resort Management and Cycle Club on their local trails
 - **Race 4**, Shimano Bike Buller Festival, 10-11 March. Conducted by Rapid Ascent on the trails at Mt Buller

- The categories contested as part of the Victorian Enduro Tour are listed below. Category series results will be calculated in each of these categories.
 - o Under 15 – male and female
 - o Under 17 – male and female
 - o Under 19 – male and female
 - o Sport – male and female
 - o Expert – male and female
 - o Elite – male and female
 - o Veteran (30-39yrs) – male and female
 - o Masters (40+ years) – male and female
 - o Super Masters (50+) – male and female
 - The winner of the Elite Male and Elite Female categories will be known as the 2017 - 2018 Victorian Enduro Tour Champions.
 - Categories will be based upon your age on the day of the final race of the series.
 - Riders must start every race in the 2017 – 2018 Victorian Enduro Tour in order to generate a category series result.
 - Results in each category, at each race will be calculated by adding together the riders' times for each of the timed stages that that category races over. The fastest cumulative time across all stages will be recognised as first place in their category in that race.
 - Riders will be awarded points according to the place they finish within their category at each race. The points awarded for each place are as per the schedule at the bottom of this document [basically The Enduro World Series women's points system (we've chosen the Women's system as it more closely matches the number of riders participating in the Victorian Enduro Tour races and is thus fairer and a more accurate distribution than the mens)]. The same points structure will be used for all categories in The Victorian Enduro Tour.
 - The points a rider receives for each race will be added together and the rider with the highest total points will be recognised as first place in their category across The Series.
 - Where points are tied in the same category, the winner will be the rider with the fastest cumulative time from all events.
 - Riders must compete in the same category at each race in order to generate a category series result.
 - Incomplete events:
 - o Where a rider starts a race but does not complete all stages designated for their category (eg. because of mechanical) they will be listed in the race results behind all riders who did complete all requires stages.
 - o They will receive a time of 25mins for the stage that was missed but will still be listed in the results for that race.
 - o A rider who misses one stage will not be placed in the results above a rider who completes all stages.
 - o Where a rider misses more than one stage they will be given a time of 25mins for each stage they miss. A rider will be ranked below any other rider who has completed more stages that they have. (Eg, a rider who misses 2 stages will be ranked below all riders who missed only one stage or who did not miss any stages).
 - [This system is set in place so riders may still receive points and thus a series result even if they do not complete the entire course for their category (DNF).]
 - Incomplete series:
 - o A rider who does not start at least one stage in all races in the series will not be given a series result in their category, irrespective of whether they entered all races in the series or not.
